TEL-ME-MOR WEBSITE

Purpose

The goal of this deliverable is to create a project website for internal and external use including links to relevant IST projects, policies and contact points, other relevant EU policies and initiatives, cross-border initiatives, events and other links as a resources for would-be participants of the 6th Framework Programme. A website as a freely and widely accessible information resource is of key importance in delivering information on TEL-ME-MOR project and research and development opportunities of the European Commission to all interested parties. In addition it will also serve as a repository of documents for project partners, a place to exchange and publish information relevant to project team only.

Coordination

TEL-ME-MOR website has been created in cooperation of the National Library of Estonia and Eremo srl. Creation and design process began already in January 2005 before the official start of the project. The National Library of Estonia purchased a domain for the website in the beginning of February 2005 - it will be maintained for two years till the end of the project.

TEL-ME-MOR website was fully designed by Kadri Aavik, the web editor of the National Library of Estonia. Content has been provided by Eremo srl and the European Commission. Structure of the website has been determined in discussions between the above mentioned three institutions. All project partners have been able to give their suggestions and comments on design, structure and content.

The website was created with an overall goal to provide all English-speaking web users information on the project and opportunities of the European Union via one central information resource with simple, but attractive design and easy navigation. The same principles apply to the restricted Partners Area intended for the use of project team only.

The maintenance of the website is the responsibility of the National Library of Estonia.

Current situation

TEL-ME-MOR website was announced in public on the 2nd of February, 2005. Over the period of next six months the structure and content of the website were revised to produce a finalised version by the end of July 2005 (along with deliverable 4.2.2 that comprises the creation of up to 10 localised TEL-ME-MOR websites).

While the website in general is static, there are sections that will change on regular basis. Project news (<http://telmemor.net/news.php>) & EU news (http://telmemor.net/eu_news.php) are updated regularly once or twice a week. Other updates are made whenever new information becomes available.
