Purpose

To ensure that information on TEL-ME-MOR project and on opportunities for research and development provided by the European Commission is made available in the official languages of the New Member States. Websites as freely and widely accessible information resources are of key importance in delivering such information to the target audiences of TEL-ME-MOR project. As national libraries of the New Member States are partners in TEL-ME-MOR project, it is only logical that their official homepages are being used as first means to disseminate information in the local languages of the New Member States.

Coordination

The content to be translated has been compiled and prepared by Eremo srl. The overall coordination of translation and publishing activities was carried out by the National Library of Estonia as WP4 leader. The translations were made by the national libraries of the New Member States under the supervision of their local WP4 leaders. Published information focuses on introducing the goals, activities and partners of TEL-ME-MOR project, IST Programme, the 6th Framework Programme and Call 4.

Current situation

As of 15 February 2005 most partners have required information available on their websites. Due to the problems with legal status of the National Library and Archives of Malta their translation will be published somewhat later, probably in March 2005.
