1. Introduction

In this first report on using and disseminating knowledge, the terms of use and dissemination of the results of the TEL-ME-MOR project are described. This is an interim report, which has been regularly updated to provide a detailed account of the project's undertaken and planned dissemination activities. The document will be produced in a final version in month 24. The final report will provide information on all activities undertaken by TEL-ME-MOR and on the future route to full use and dissemination of the knowledge produced by the project.

2. TEL-ME-MOR goals and objectives

TEL-ME-MOR is a project funded by the European Commission Directorate-General Information Society and Media, Unit E3, Learning and Cultural Heritage, under the [Sixth Framework Programme](#) of the [Information Society Technologies \(IST\) Programme](#). TEL-ME-MOR aims at stimulating and facilitating the participation of organisations from the New Member States (NMS) of the European Union in projects funded within the Information Society Technologies area. The project also supports the 10 national libraries from the NMS in becoming full members of The European Library (<http://portal.theeuropeanlibrary.org/>). an initiative, established under the aegis of the Conference of European National Librarians (CENL - <http://www.cenl.org/>), providing unified access to the digitised and non-digitised collections of the National Libraries of Europe. The European Library will in the future encompass access to all the cultural heritage of Europe available in museums or archives, thereby creating new research opportunities as well as ease of access for everyone, from everywhere, at any time.

TEL-ME-MOR main objectives are:

- Providing a more comprehensive and more easily **searchable pan-European collection of top quality information resources** covering all subject areas of interest to the research community
- Enhancing the ability of NMS **researchers** to access resources in all pertinent languages through multilingual interfaces
- Overcoming the digital divide between new and old Member States by improving support for any researcher at any time and from anywhere
- Raising awareness amongst **policy makers, research funding bodies and the research, scholarly and IT communities** about the tools and services available through national library networks
- Raising awareness of the IST Programme in NMS and increasing participation of organisations from these countries in future IST calls for proposals relating to learning and cultural heritage
- Promoting the use of the TEL-ME-MOR libraries' resources made available via The European Library.

3. Planned dissemination: objectives, activities, target audiences

What to disseminate

TEL-ME-MOR aims to disseminate information on:

- Goals and activities of the European Commission's Learning & Cultural Heritage Unit
- Current and future IST calls for proposals in the Culture & Learning areas
- Project progress and results
- Resources made gradually available by the project via The European Library.

Target audiences

TEL-ME-MOR targets all the stakeholders involved in building the knowledge society from the cultural, educational, industrial and public sectors. In particular, the project aims to reach the following audiences:

- Drawing up of an interim **plan for using and disseminating knowledge** (D4.6)
- Drawing up of a **final report on using and disseminating knowledge** (D4.7)
- Drawing up of a **report on raising public participation and awareness** demonstrating the extent to which actors beyond the research community have been involved to help spread awareness and to explore the wider societal implications of TEL-ME-MOR (D4.8)

Description of main activities

PROJECT WEB SITE

Since the start of the project the TEL-ME-MOR web site has been enhanced and expanded to become an informative and user-friendly portal, offering up-to-date information on EU calls for proposals, events and digital developments within the IST area, in addition to informing on project progress and results.

The portal is structured into two main sections: one focusing on project's activities and relevant news and events, and the second devoted to EU developments and projects opportunities, which regularly publishes information on calls, events and relevant EU activities in the Culture and Learning areas. The portal also

includes a section devoted to project ideas and partners' search in the NMS with regard to IST projects within the Learning and Cultural sectors and one on 'Related projects'. The local web sites linked to from the main menu, mirror the content of the main portal, while also publishing additional information and news on local events and developments in the IST area, in the 10 New Members.

Since its publication, the average number of unique visitors to the portal has been of about 663 users per month. The number has grown in October 2005, reaching 795 visitors. The average number of visits per month is 1.359, meaning that a large number of visitors visit the site at least twice or three times per month.

As to the number of visitors by country, NMS are in the top ten: Estonia, Hungary, Lithuania, Poland, Slovenia and the Czech Republic, while amongst the 'Old Member States', Germany, Netherlands and Switzerland has registered the highest number of visits. The project site has also attracted visitors from other countries in the world, namely, Russia, Egypt, Canada, Morocco, USA, Indonesia and Australia.

TARGETTED DISSEMINATION

Since the start, the project's partners (particularly the NMS partners) have focused their dissemination activities on a wide range of audiences, namely, ministries of culture, education, research, science, information, local authorities, individual libraries, museums and archives, as well as museum and archive networks and associations. In addition to that, the project has been regularly disseminating information via existing networks, including the IDEAL-IST List, National Contact Points, CALIMERA and Euro Info centres, thus reaching out SMEs, small size libraries, museums and archives and many other cultural institutions and ICT companies in the NMS, which have been kept updated with the developments of TEL-ME-MOR, informed about initiatives and activities of the EC (call for proposals, events etc.) and encouraged to participate in future projects in the cultural and learning sectors.

As an example, most of the audiences, which are being targeting by TEL-ME-MOR were represented at the Information Day organised by the project on 29 June 2005, in Tallinn, Estonia. Out of 82 participants, 25 were libraries, five archives, 9 museums, two ministries, 22 cultural centres, associations, and NGOs, 4 theatres, 7 colleges and universities, two SMEs, 3 local authorities and two EC-related agencies.

DISSEMINATION ON CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Liaising with NMS NCPs for disseminating information on IST Call 4 and 5 and for encouraging organisation of Information Days on Call 5

During February and March 2005 the project undertook an intensive dissemination action about Call 4, published by the European Commission in December 2004 and closed on 22 March 2005. The call offered interesting opportunities for NMS, encouraging specifically their involvement in the 'enlarged Europe'. TEL-ME-MOR posted relevant information on the project web site and circulated an informative press release via a number of existing European networks, including [National Contact Points](#), [IDEAL-IST List](#), [Minerva](#), [Calimera](#) and others. Although, having the project started in February, dissemination happened to take place quite close to the call's deadline, this activity proved useful in many ways, preparing the ground for future dissemination actions and raising the interest of a number of institutions, which expressed their willingness to take part in future IST calls. Partners from the NMS established preliminary contacts with organisations and national networks, which are and will be used to channel information and raise awareness on future projects' opportunities throughout the project duration.

Extensive dissemination was carried out in relation to Call 5, opened on 18 May 2005 and closed on 21 September 2005. Besides disseminating information via the above mentioned channels (regular mailings via various contacts and networks, web site etc.) to promote the call and encourage participation in NMS, TEL-ME-MOR liaised with NMS NCPs in order to encourage and promote the organisation of Information Days devoted to the call. As a result, a number of such

Vilnius, Lithuania, 28 June 2005

Information Day organised by Lithuanian National Contact Point and focused on all Strategic Objectives under Call 5, including Strategic Objective 2.5.10 - Access to and preservation of cultural and scientific resources. The National Library of Lithuania introduced the activities and goals of TEL-ME-MOR project.

Warsaw, Poland, 28 June 2005

Organised by the Polish National Contact Point and focused on strategic priorities 1 and 5. The event provided an overview of opportunities under Call 5.

[IST Call 5 - Information Day and Project Preparation Workshop](#)

Budapest, Hungary 15 - 16 June 2005

Organised by the PRO NMS project. The event focused on micro/nano based subsystems, embedded systems, software and services, ICT for networked businesses and cultural heritage. The National Library of Hungary as a partner in TEL-ME-MOR delivered a presentation on the project and on Strategic Objective 2.5.10.

Dissemination on eContentplus Call and IST Call 6

TEL-ME-MOR has extensively promoted the [first eContentplus call for proposals](#), which closed on 24 November 2005. The programme (2005–08) promotes and facilitates accessibility and usability of digital material in a multilingual environment and the first call addressed geographic, educational, cultural, scientific and scholarly content.

In January 2006 TEL-ME-MOR started to promote the new IST Call 6 via the above-mentioned dissemination channels. This action is ongoing and will continue until the closing of the call. The call which opened on 22 December 2005 and will close on 25 April 2006, addresses new technology, application domains and approaches such as integrated environments or experience research.

DISSEMINATION ON THE EC STRATEGY FOR DIGITAL LIBRARIES

The new strategy was announced by the European Commission in September 2005 and aims to make Europe's written and audiovisual heritage available on the Internet and proposing a concerted action by EU Member States to digitise, preserve, and make this heritage available to all. To this purpose, the Commission presented a first set of actions at European level and invited comments on a series of issues in an online consultation, which closed on 20 January 2006. Responses will feed into a proposal for a Recommendation on digitisation and digital preservation, to be presented in June 2006.

TEL-ME-MOR made a special effort to promote the Strategy and to encourage participation in the on-line consultation, targeting, in particular, NMS. The project team prepared and sent out a series of mailings to various EU networks, while the NMS disseminated information in their own language via their local web sites, contacts and networks. The communication and consultation were also pointed out and announced several times on the TEL-ME-MOR web site.

PROJECT EVENTS (AS FROM WORK PLAN)

National workshops – The organisation of the workshops was one of the activities of WP1, whose overall aim is to investigate the requirements of national libraries and their clients from the research and technological application sector, focusing on research and new services to build the knowledge communities in the NMS in areas relevant to the IST programme.

The events were conducted in the 10 NMS in July-August 2005. The workshops discussed and validated the results of a survey (D1.1 – available from: <http://telmemor.net/results.php>), carried out by WP1, to investigate the current situation of the 10 National Libraries as to R&D activities. The main areas covered at the events were: research requirements of the national libraries, technical preparation for joining The European Library, application of international standards in local library systems, awareness raising and information dissemination on The European Library and on research opportunities within the IST Programme.

According to the work plan, the Project Newsletter is to be produced in three issues throughout the project timeframe. Besides being used at the Information Day in Luxembourg and at the IFLA Conference in Oslo, these materials have been displayed and distributed by the NMS national libraries and their partner institutions at key local events and exhibitions (see Annex 1).

DISSEMINATION ON CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Dissemination on results of IST Calls 4, 5 and 6 – TEL-ME-MOR will widely disseminate information on the results of Calls 4, 5 and 6 by using its established dissemination channels, including project web site, regular mailings to National Contact Points, EU Delegations, Euro Info Centres, existing networks and NMS partners' local contacts.

ANNEX 1

PROJECT NEWSLETTER was sent via e-mail to the University of Cyprus, Cyprus Museum, Ministry of Education and Culture, colleges, academic and public libraries.

NATIONAL EVENTS

The Cyprus Library organised a ***national workshop in the framework of TEL-ME-MOR WP1 on 24 June, 2005***. This event was attended by representatives of ministries, EU National Contact Point, libraries, universities, trade associations and national press. The Director of the Cyprus Library, Mr. Antonis Maratheftis, gave a speech on TEL-ME-MOR and The European Library.

TRADE ASSOCIATIONS CONTACTS

In Cyprus there are no librarianship/information science associations. The Cyprus Library makes use of its connections with the Chamber of Commerce, Research Promotion Foundation and Cyprus Computer Society.

TRADE PRESS

No professional library journals are published in Cyprus.

NATIONAL AND REGIONAL PRESS

The invitation to the TEL-ME-MOR WP1 national workshop (24 June 2005) was published in all daily newspapers. The library sent press releases on TEL-ME-MOR events and progress to national and regional press and will continue doing so in the future.

DISSEMINATION ON CALLS

IST CALL 4

Information on Call 4 was disseminated via the EU National Contact Point, Ministry of Education and Culture, University of Cyprus and to various colleagues in other libraries. The Cyprus Library has not received any feedback, but they do not expect it either – they suppose the interested parties contact EU institutions or the Research Promotion Foundation (IST NCP) directly, because those institutions promote the same programmes and calls.

IST CALL 5

Information on Call 5 was sent to the EU National Contact Point, Ministry of Education and Culture, University of Cyprus and other libraries. The Strategic Objective 2.5.10 was introduced at the TEL-ME-MOR WP1 national workshop on 24th of June, 2005, and at the Call 5 national information days organised by the Research Promotion Foundation, which however, the Cyprus Library was unable to attend.

eContentplus

The above mentioned networks and institutions were targeted to disseminate information on this call. In result, the Library received three expressions of interest.

Digital Libraries Strategy

The Library communicated their views to the Ministry of Culture and Education; the latter presented its official viewpoint to the Commission in November 2005. The position of the National Library of Cyprus was included in the responses by CENL and CALIMERA. Summary of the Strategy was mailed to the contacts mentioned above.

IST CALL 6

By the time of submitting this report the library had started dissemination on IST Call 6, but results are not yet known. They will be published in the next report.

PROJECT WEB SITE

The Cyprus Library web site is at the time merely a sub-section of the Cyprus Ministry of Education and Culture, but the library is in process of designing a new web site. Links to The European Library portal and to the local TEL-ME-MOR web site will be published as soon as the site is finalised.

TEL-ME-MOR local web site (http://www.moec.gov.cy/cyprus_library/telmemor_greek.htm) is located also at the server of the Ministry of Education and Culture. It is currently linked from the web site of the Ministry (http://www.moec.gov.cy/cyprus_library/) and registered in **CyprusNet** web directory (<http://www.cyprusnet.com/>). Registration in **FirstCyprus** (<http://www.1stcyprus.com/>) and **GO2** (<http://www.go2.com.cy/>) search engines is pending.

After the new web site of the Cyprus Library will be available, statistics can be provided on the access to the TEL-ME-MOR local web site.

INTERNAL COMMUNICATION

The staff of the Cyprus Library is kept informed on the developments and results of the project via regular mailings and presentations at meetings.

2. THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Updated: 30 January 2006

POSTERS and LEAFLETS (in English) were displayed at the Librarianship Institute and at the Library & Information Science Literature Library of the National Library of the Czech Republic. Leaflets were distributed to 24 universities and colleges in the Czech Republic.

In particular, the educational department

was interested in the opportunities for school libraries to participate in EU projects.

IST CALL 5

Information on Call 5 was sent to all institutions mentioned above (see MAILING LISTS and LOCAL NETWORKS). The National Library held a national information day on 29th of June, 2005, focused on Call 5 and the Strategic Objective 2.5.10. Presentations were made on Call 5, SO 2.5.10, Culture 2000, EU structural funds, projects TEL-ME-MOR and reUSE. Full programme in English is available at <http://telmemor.net/tmmevents.php>. As a result of the information day, Ian Pigott, EC Project Officer, who was present at the event, was contacted by representatives of the Information Centre of Tartu University Hospital and the National Archives interested to learn more about opportunities to participate in EU programmes. The National Library of Estonia illustrated Call 5 and TEL-ME-MOR to the Academic Library of Tallinn University and to the Narva Museum. The National Library has also been assisting IST NCP in passing on partner searches from EU, Turkey, Russia and Israel. The National Library of Estonia could not attend the Call 5 Information Day in Luxemburg, on 16 June 2005, because of inadequate financial resources.

eContentplus

Information on Call 1 of eContentplus programme was sent to all institutions mentioned above (see MAILING LISTS and LOCAL NETWORKS). The National Library of Estonia received feedback from several libraries as well as from the Tallinn City Museum, which showed an interest in submitting a proposal. In general, however, it was noticed, that most potential submissions lacked an international (European) dimension, being mainly focused on local development.

Digital Libraries Strategy

The National Library of Estonia sent information on the Digital Libraries Strategy twice, in October and November 2005, to all its contacts via local electronic newsletters. The official viewpoint of the Ministry of Culture was represented to the European Commission in November 2005. Several internal meetings to discuss the Strategy took place in the National Library. The National Library's official response to the Communication was submitted to the Commission on 17 January 2006 (http://europa.eu.int/information_society/activities/digital_libraries/consultation/replies/consult_results/national_library_estonia_a302075.pdf).

IST CALL 6

Information on IST Call 6 is being sent to all institutions mentioned above (see MAILING LISTS and LOCAL NETWORKS). No feedback has not yet been received.

The average number of visitors is 400 per month, total number of visits over 1000.

INTERNAL COMMUNICATION

The main channel used for disseminating information to the staff of the National Library is a weekly newsletter. In addition to that the intranet, general mailing list and presentations at information days are used to keep the staff updated on TEL-ME-MOR developments and results.
